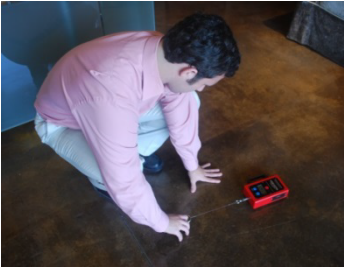




## PPI E-012 Walkway Auditor Certificate Holder Program (WACH) Brochure 2017



The National Floor Safety Institute's (NFSI) Walkway Auditor Certificate Holder Training course is designed to provide the attendee with the necessary information on how to properly conduct a walkway safety inspection under OSHA's proposed new rule for "Walking and Working Surfaces" and bring you up to date on recently released ANSI/NFSI B101 Standards. The Course covers:

- OSHA's revised Walking and Working Surface Requirements
- How and why slips, trips and falls occur
- Floor covering materials and their recommended applications
- Proper floor maintenance methods and procedures
- Hands-on use of various walkway tribometers

Participants that complete all four days and score an 80% or higher on the assessment will be recognized by NFSI as a Walkway Auditor Certificate Holder (WACH) for three years.
